A recognized veterans' leader and keynote speaker, Dr. Brauckmiller has shared his insights at prestigious events, including the Walden University Research Conference and Residency in 2018. His dedication to supporting veterans extends beyond academia, as he has actively worked to improve resources and opportunities for service members and their families. He has served as a Veteran School Certifying Official (VACSO), assisting veterans in navigating their educational pathways, and has been a vocal advocate for policies and initiatives that enhance veterans' quality of life.
